**WHEREAS**: the Council of the Village of Racine, Ohio has established an additional office for the direction of Code Enforcement to better serve the citizens of the Village by maintaining a well-kept village, and

WHEREAS: Said office will function under the Council and Office of the Mayor, the daily operations will follow the standard operating procedures of the Marshal/ Police Department.

## THEREFOR: BE IT ORDAINED by the Racine Village Council that

Section 1: The Legislative Authority hereby approved the SOP for the Code Enforcement as presented as such for the operating functions of the Code Enforcement Department.

Section 2: At any time the Legislative Authority or the Marshal feels the Code Enforcement Officer does not comply with the policy set forth of the SOP or stay up to date on required certification and trainings the said officer shall be removed from said position until such time a complete hearing is held with the Legislative Authority and Marshal's office.

Section 3: The Legislative Authority has the right to remove or add any or all sections of the SOP on code enforcement at any Council Meeting to protect the Village of Racine and its citizens as seen fit.
