

ORDINANCE # 1071

An Ordinance to establish a Code Enforcement Officer to serve the Village of Racine, Ohio, to better serve the citizens of the Village and maintain the overall appearance.

WHEREAS: the Council of the Village of Racine, Ohio proposes to establish a Code Enforcement Officer, to serve the Village and enforce the established Village and Codes of the State of Ohio, and

WHEREAS: The Council of the Village of Racine has adopted a basis for the enforcement of codes, to maintain the overall appearance of the Village.


THEREFOR: BE IT ORDAINED by the Racine Village Council that

- Section 1: Upon proper passage, the Mayor of the Village of Racine, with the confirmation of the Legislative Authority appoint such person to fill the position of the Code Enforcement Officer.
- Section 2: Such Appointee shall be placed on regular patrol with set hours approved by the Legislative Authority, depending on the finances of the General fund.
- Section 3: The appointed code enforcement officer shall operate under the rules set forth by the state of Ohio and the Village Legislative Authority and follow the Standard Operating Procedures of the Marshal's/ Police section of the Code Enforcement and follow the Village of Racine's employee handbook.
- Section 4: The Village of Racine's Legislative Authority has the right to suspend the Office of Code Enforcement, add, or reduce hours to reflect current operation budget. It is the full intent of the Legislative Authority to maintain a clean and safe Village at all times and operate on a functional budget.
